Fire Chief's Report	<ul> <li>Fire Chief Joe Spagnuolo reported the following:</li> <li>a.) Light/Air 47 has been having issues with the fill station. A technician came out several times and believe the issue is now resolved.</li> <li>b.) Pass through door issues with Fire Station 1 (east side) and Fire Station 3. Doors are not latching tightly.</li> <li>c.) Furnace issues at Fire Station 1. Last month, the apparatus bay furnace was inspected and repaired (west section) and then the furnace went out in the office area. Williams Heating and Cooling were contacted and came right out to complete the repairs.</li> </ul>

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	<ul> <li>d.) Fire Station 1 offices were completed after the new carpet was installed. Firefighter Zischke, Firefighter DeSander, and Asst.
